In preparation for our shows, there are two very important sets of dates to mark in your calendar:

- **Tech Week at United Talent: On-Stage Dress Rehearsal & Pictures – Monday, May 20th thru Friday, May 24th**
- **Shows at United Talent – Thursday, May 30th thru Sunday, June 2nd** (see information at end of packet for which show(s) your child will perform in)
 - Thursday, May 30th at 6:30pm
 - Friday, May 31st at 6:30pm
 - Saturday, June 1st at 1:30pm & 6:30pm
 - Sunday, June 2nd at 1:30pm & 6:30pm

Other important dates are highlighted throughout the packet. There will be no classes or rehearsals May 27th-29th. Originally, our Recital was set to begin on Wednesday, May 29th, but that has since changed due to scheduling.



FLOWERS

Georgetown Flowers is our flower vendor again this year. Orders through Georgetown Flowers will be available for pick up prior to each show in the lobby of United Talent. Orders will be accepted online until the day before Recital begins, **Wednesday, May 29th**.

VIDEOGRAPHY

Something Mohr Productions will be videoing the Recital performances again this year! DVDs and Jump Drives will be available for purchase and mailed to you this summer. Videography is **strictly prohibited** during the shows! **Link for ordering will be available closer to the Recital.**

PHOTOGRAPHY

Terri Behrens Photography will be photographing class group photos, individual portraits and taking action shots during the shows! There is no upfront fee for photos. There will be gallery viewing online available a few days after Recital. Photography is **strictly prohibited** during the shows!

- Picture Week will coincide with our Dress Rehearsal during Tech Week (May 20th-24th).

- The class will be photographed as a whole and then individuals that sign up will be photographed individually. Please sign up for a slot where your dancer's class is listed.

"DANCE WITH ME" OPPORTUNITY

A crowd favorite each year! Dancers can perform on stage with a special Adult in their life. This can be a Parent, Grandparent, Aunt/Uncle, Guardian, etc. over the age of 18. Dancer and their partner will attend rehearsal on **Friday, May 10th** to learn their choreography! We will divide into two groups based on the age of the dancer. There will be detailed rehearsal videos as well for the pair to practice with at home. The pair can perform in just 1 or multiple of the Recital shows.

- Costume Info: The pair should have a coordinating outfit! Feel free to match the "wild" theme of the routines, or stick with "Sunday best" attire.

COSTUMES

- As costumes are tried on at UT and sent home with the dancer, a few reminders:
 - Place costumes on a hanger and keep all accessories/hair pieces with costume
 - Costumes are NOT to be worn to dance class (until Tech Week), worn to school, worn around the house, etc before Recital. After Recital ends, their yours to do whatever with!
 - Costumes are not 'custom fit' and may require a few alterations or safety pins to fix straps, hem length, etc.
 - If needed, steaming the wrinkles out of costume is fine, but no ironing.
- Please be prepared with "put together" costume items or anything listed that you should provide (tights, shoes, etc.)
- Costumes along with proper hair and makeup should be worn to Tech Week May 20th-24th.

HAIR & MAKEUP

For females, hair should be worn as listed below and should apply stage makeup. Seek YouTube tutorials for help in executing these steps. Male dancers should have their hair out of their face, and are welcome to apply light stage makeup if they wish.

3-6yr combo classes (Ballet/Tap, Ballet/Jazz/Tap, or Ballet/Acro)

High Ballet Bun:

- gather hair into high ponytail at crown of head
- using bobby pins & hair pins, twist hair in spiral motion and pin to head
- finish with hair colored net around bun, and hairspray for fly-away/wispy hairs

Hip Hop classes

Low Ponytail:

- hair can be side part, center part, straight back, braided, etc.
- gather hair in ponytail at nape of neck
- if your dancer has other classes, they can leave their hair in a bun instead of switching to the ponytail

Adult Classes - any hair style of choice!

All other classes not listed above (including PAC)

- **For PAC:** middle-part slick low bun
- **For Recreational Dancers:** low bun
 - hair can be side part, center part, straight back, braided, etc.
 - gather hair in ponytail at nape of the neck
 - using bobby pins & hair pins, twist hair in spiral motion and pin to head
 - finish with hair colored net around bun, and hairspray for fly-away/wispy hairs

Makeup: Stage lights will wash out dancers and make their features hard to see. The more, the better when it comes to makeup! We understand that it is difficult to apply makeup on younger dancers – do your best!

- Foundation - should be one shade darker than dancer's skin. Bronzer will also help for fair skin tones.
- Blush - pinkish tones are best. Brush heavily along dancer's cheekbones.
- Eyes - neutral color eyeshadows, eyeliner on top and bottom eyelids & mascara. For younger dancers, we understand that this can be difficult and is optional. Just do your best! We want their eyes to show up from stage.
- Lips - all female dancers need to have RED lipstick! Be sure to bring this with you, as it will need to be re-applied often.

TECH WEEK: ON-STAGE DRESS REHEARSAL & PICTURE WEEK

The week of May 20th-24th is our final week of class before Recital and Tech Week! This is a big week and we want to make sure everything runs smoothly.

- Dancers should arrive at United Talent at their normal class time – even 5 minutes early would be great!! Please use the entrance on the left side of our building (closest to Studio C).
- They should be dressed in their Recital costume with hair and makeup completed. There will not be time to do this upon arrival.
 - For 3-4yr & 5-6yr Ballet/Acro or Ballet/Jazz/Tap classes that have two costumes in one class, please arrive in their ballet costume first.
 - For dancers that have back-to-back classes, please come in the costume for their earliest class of the day and there will be dressing room space for them to change into their next costume.
 - It's advised for parents of dancers age 8 and younger to stay in the building this day, especially if they need assistance changing costumes, tights, etc.
- Dancers will meet with their teacher in Studio C/D, check all costumes and then proceed to the photography area. The class will be photographed as a whole and then individuals that sign up will

be photographed individually. There is no upfront charge for these sessions. Following picture week, you will receive an email with a link to view and order your images online.

- You only need to sign up your dancer for individual photos in the classes with costumes you are interested in having your dancer photographed. Please sign up for a slot where your dancer's class is listed:

 - Friday sign-ups are for PAC/UFAA solos and duos, buddy shots and siblings. Those dancers will NOT rehearse on stage.
- Dancers will then proceed to the stage with their class to practice on the stage with lights and sound! Parents **are not permitted** in rehearsal as we want to keep their final performance a special surprise.
- Dancers are then dismissed! If they have a second costume or multiple classes, they will report to the dressing room area to change and then repeat the process over again. Parents are welcome to assist in the dressing room with costume changes.
- **Please note, that dancers may need to stay longer than their normal class time.** For example, if your dancer's class is only 30 or 45 minutes long, it's going to be tough to get through all of these steps in that amount of time. I would expect to be at United Talent **for at least an hour**. If your dancer's class is 1 ½ hours long, there should be plenty of time to finish all of these steps.

TICKETS

Ticket will be reserved seating and go on sale **Monday, May 20th at 9am: [http://](http://21605.encoreticketing.com)**

21605.encoreticketing.com. They will continue to be sold online until the beginning of show time.

Everybody in the audience will need to purchase a ticket, with the exception of children under age 3 who may sit in an adult lap. **Dancers do not need a ticket, as they will remain in the dressing rooms for the duration of the show.** If you have any trouble with tickets, you will need to go through the ticketing company via the link at the footer of www.encoreticketing.com.

We do anticipate some of our shows being SOLD OUT, so please don't wait to purchase tickets. They will go fast!!

RECITAL RULES

Participation in Recital is fun and exciting for students and families alike. The following rules have proven successful in the past, so thank you in advance for your cooperation!

- There will be no classes or rehearsals May 27th-29th.
- On Recital Day, dancers (already dressed in their first costume with hair and makeup completed) & dressing room monitor volunteers should arrive **30 minutes** before the show begins. One parent can escort the dancer into the dressing room area.
- Seating for audience will open 30 minutes before each show as well.
- During the show, one parent per dancer should return to dressing room to change assist their child with changing costumes. Our dance studios will be used as dressing rooms, some designated for females only and one for our male dancers.
- All dancers will remain in the dressing room for the entirety of the show and participate in the Finale at the end. It's encouraged for young dancers to bring something for entertainment (books, small toys), and UT will provide coloring sheets as well.
- After the show, dancers will be dismissed from the stage to greet family in the audience.

- For the End of Show/Finale, all dancers should remain in costume (their last one if they have multiple)! All dancers will be learning a short dance for all of them to perform together at the end.
- No food or drink (except water) may be consumed while in costumes.
- For females, no undergarments need to be worn under tights. All tap shoe strings should be tied in double knots. Strings in ballet shoes should be knotted, cut to an inch in length, & tucked in. No jewelry (except small rhinestone stud earrings) or nail polish may be worn.
- Please include your dancer's name on all of their belongings. United Talent will not be responsible for lost items.
- No photography or videotaping allowed of dancer's on stage. Please purchase photos & videos from our professional vendors.
- ***To participate in Recital, any outstanding tuition/fees must be paid by May 15th, 2024!***

ARRIVAL ON SHOW DAYS & PARKING

- Before each show, dancers (already dressed in their first costume with hair and makeup completed) & dressing room monitor volunteers should arrive **30 minutes** before the show begins. One parent can escort the dancer into the dressing room area.
- Seating for audience will open 30 minutes before each show as well.
- Our main parking lot, the closest side of Kaden Lane, and other marked parking areas will be available. Please AVOID parking in areas marked with NO PARKING signs.

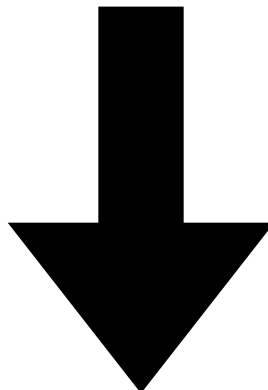
PRACTICING FOR RECITAL

- We ask that dancers practice at home as well.

RECITAL SHOW ORDERS
